Sec. 1-4.08 that the Planning Commission of the City of California City will consider an appeal of the Planning Director's February 26, 2026, determination approving Site Plan Review 25-09 for the California City Correctional Facility located at 22844 Virginia Boulevard, California City, CA 93505 (APN 350-031-28-2). Jehan Laner, on behalf of Dignity Not Detention Coalition, appealed the Planning Director's approval of Site Plan Review 25-09. The Planning Commission's decision will be de novo and will be based upon the appeal, the complete administrative record, the official staff report, oral testimony, and any written comments or supplemental materials submitted prior to or during the public hearing. Following deliberate consideration of the matter, the Planning Commission may uphold, modify, reverse, or remand the Planning Director's determination.
