Sec. 1-4.08 that the City Council of the City of California City will consider an appeal of the City Manager's Decision dated July 7, 2026, determination approving the issuance of a Business License for the California City Correctional Facility located at 22844 Virginia Boulevard, California City, CA 93505 (APN 350-031-28- 2). Jehan Laner, on behalf of Immigrant Legal Resource Center and Dignity Not Detention Coalition, appealed the City Manager's decision to uphold the City Clerk's issuance of a business license to CoreCivic Inc. Following deliberate consideration of the matter, the City Council may uphold, modify, reverse, or remand the City Manager determination.
